Kiddiwinks is a well established home from home private day nursery and pre-school situated in a quiet and easily accessible location just off Scalby Road, Scarborough. Established in 1998, we care for children from birth to 5 years of age, in an intimate and loving atmosphere with space for just 6 babies and 15 pre-school children.

Our fully qualified and loyal staff are trained to degree level with the owner having her Early Years Professional Status and are totally committed to providing a safe, loving and stimulating environment which caters for your child's every need.

At Kiddiwinks all children all children are treated individually and are cared for in conjunction with the wishes of their parents and guardians. Our ethos is reflected in the following themes of the Early Years Foundation Stage.

1. Every child is unique.
2. Positive relationships between children parents and staff support learning.
3. The learning environment should be enabling.
4. Learning and development are supported through play, exploration and creativity.

## Baby Room

Our baby room has fully qualified staff with experience in looking after babies. Areas in this room include:

- \*Various places for sleep cots, bouncy chairs and cushions

We are also keen to establish and maintain a daily routine for children. In order to provide consistency for children, parents and staff.



## What to Bring with You

- \*A written routine for your baby (with as much detail as possible) a form will be provided.

\*All milk feeds made up if on formula milk, we provide cows milk.

\*All babies food stuff's i.e. jars, packets and/or pre cooked food.

\*Nappies, spare set of clothes and any creams

\*Coat or jacket for your child for outside play on cooler days.

## Over Two's Room

Our pre-school is registered for 15 children from 2 to 5 years of age.

\*All children have a key person who completes their individual care

\*Observations and assessments are completed to feed into their NYEY profile assessments

\*Preparation for school

\*Access to all areas including messy play, construction, small world, mark making

\*Access to outside area at all times



## Mealtime

Home cooked meals are prepared onsite daily from fresh ingredients, providing a varied menu designed to give the children a healthy, nutritious meal. Snacks and a light tea are also provided. All children sit down to eat together and this becomes a social occasion at which they learn to try new foods as well as improve their table manners.

## Funded Childcare Places

All 3 and 4 year olds in England are entitled to 15 hours of free early years education or childcare each week for 38 weeks of the year (some 2 year olds may be eligible subject to certain criteria).
